H.R. 141 Social Security Fairness Act of 2019 which would repeal the Windfall Elimination Provision and the Government Pension Offset and is currently in the house Ways and Means Committee
S.1878 Universal Childhood and Early Learning Act
A bill to establish universal childcare and early learning programs.
S. 969 Educator Preparation Reform Act
A bill to improve quality and accountability for educator preparation programs.
